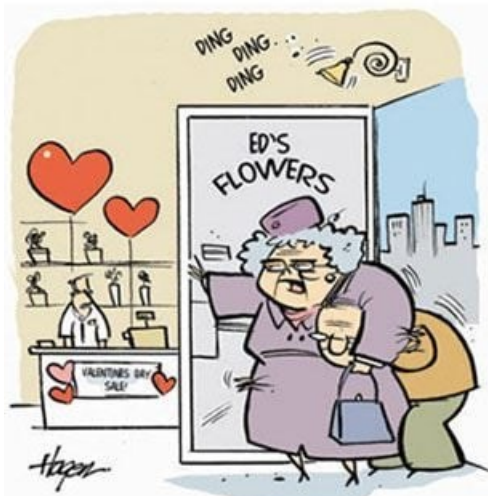

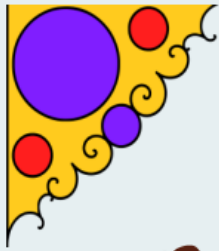

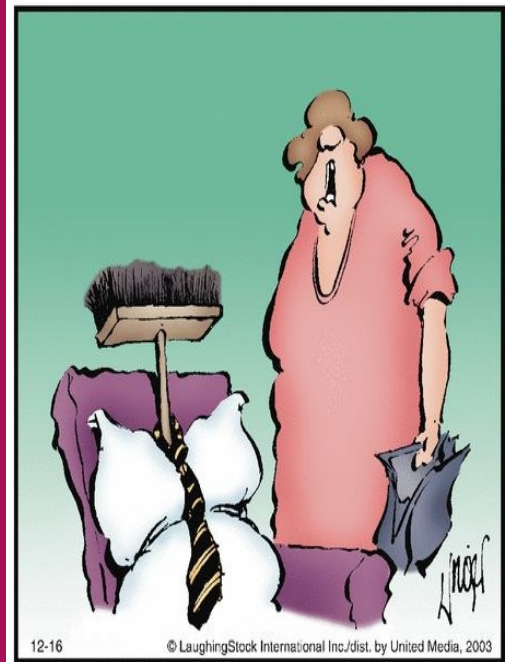

Hurry Hard! A Curling Word Search.

Curling has been described as the 'Roarin' Game', with the 'roar' coming from the noise of a granite stone as it travels over the ice. The exact origins of the game, however, are unclear, but curling is widely believed to be one of the world's oldest team sports.

Curling is played on ice, where two teams take it in turns to slide stones made of granite to-

wards a target - known as a House. It is an Olympic and Paralympic winter sport with medal disciplines for Women's, Men's, Mixed Doubles, and mixed Wheelchair teams. Traditional curling teams are made up of four players while the mixed doubles variation of the sport consists of teams of two players, one female and one male.

Curling is fun, social, and rewarding and is available in Brampton for all ages and skill levels. We've put together 22 curling terms for you to find. See if you can ice this search.
